Independent candidates do not have a primary and qualify for placement on the General Election ballot by a nominating petition. Independent Candidates must publish a Notice of Candidacy and provide a copy of publication to the Board of Elections office along with the qualifying fee by 12:00 noon on March 11, 2022. Nominating petitions for Independent Candidates are due at noon on Tuesday July 12, 2022, in the office of the Glynn County Board of Elections. The General Primary will be held May 24, 2022. The General Election will be held November 8, 2022.
