PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

By reading and signing the Glynn County Recreation and Parks Department ("GCRPD") Parents' Code of Conduct, I agree to support GCRPD's Youth Athletics Mission to develop the positive values of athletics including sportsmanship, teamwork, cooperation, and competition, and to provide as many youth as possible the opportunity to participate in activities they enjoy in a fun and safe environment.

I also agree to the following for myself and my child:

1. I pledge to remember the game is for children, not adults. I will do my part to make youth sports fun for my child.
2. I pledge to support GCRPD's Athletics Coach Mission: to improve the lives of young athletes by teaching them the values of hard work, healthy competition, sportsmanship, and a commitment to excellence, and to instill in them a knowledge and love of the game that will enable them to lead healthy lives.
3. I pledge to encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, fans, officials, and GCRPD employees at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
4. I pledge to demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and vulgar/abusive language, and will refrain from their use at all GCRPD youth sports events.
5. I pledge to treat other players, coaches, fans, officials, and GCRPD employees with respect and dignity regardless of race, creed, religion, sex, or ability.
6. I pledge to place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win. I will insist that my child plays in a safe and healthy environment.
7. I pledge to support the coaches, officials, and GCRPD employees working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
8. I pledge to be a good steward of GCRPD parks and property by picking up and disposing of my trash in a trash receptacle. I will teach my child to do the same.
